Colour and pattern run all the way through and cannot wear away. Corian® cannot delaminate. Joints are unobtrusive, creating a look that is virtually seamless.

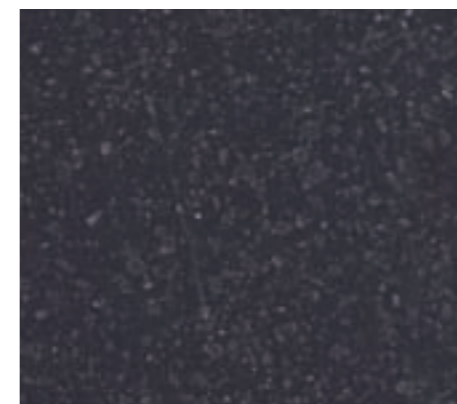
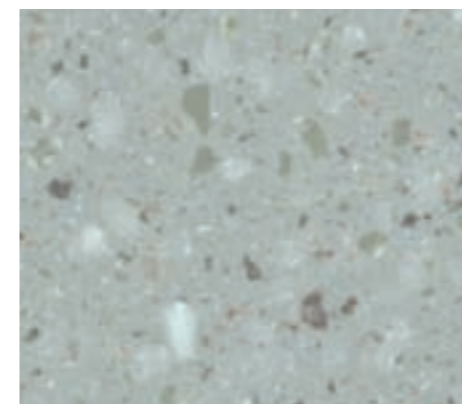
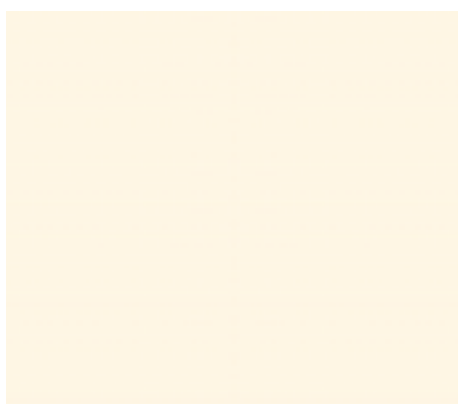
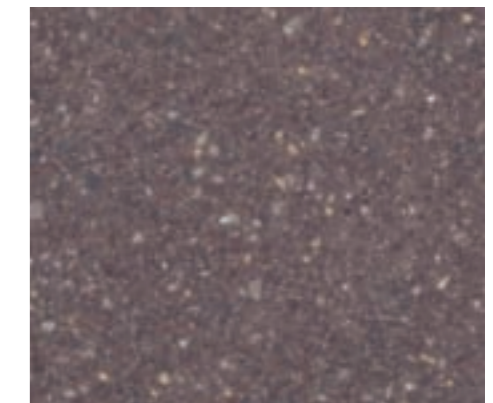
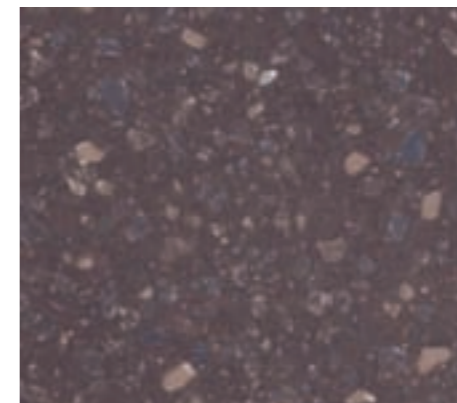
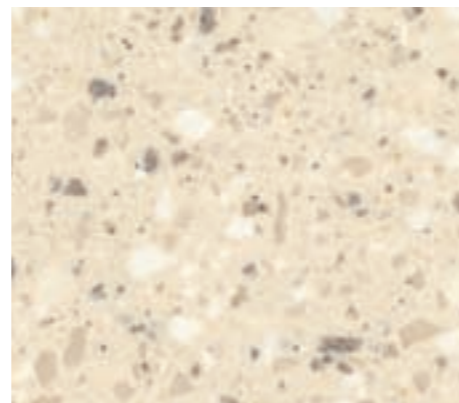
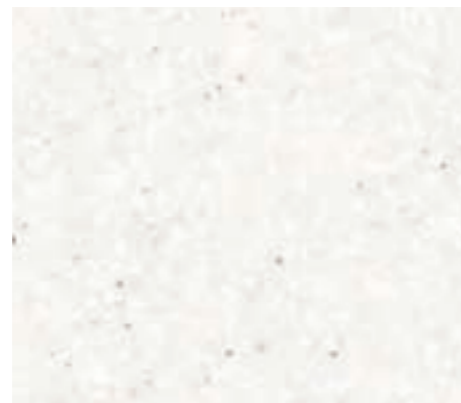
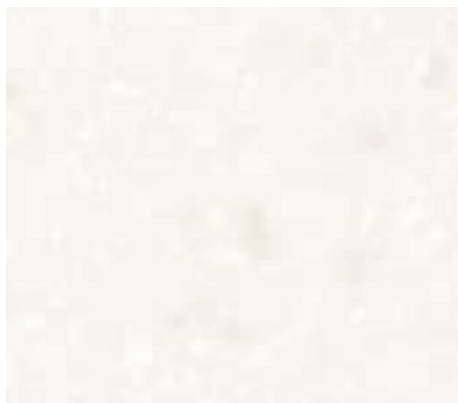
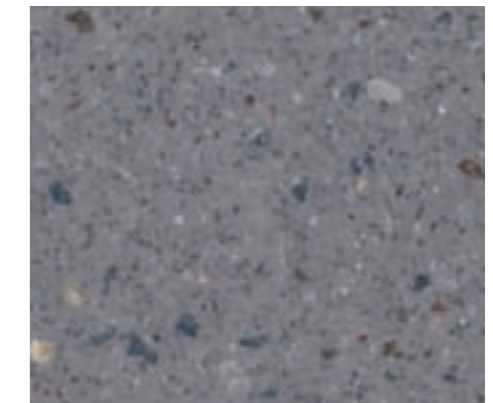
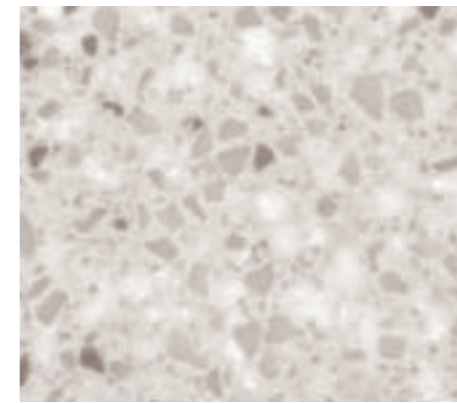
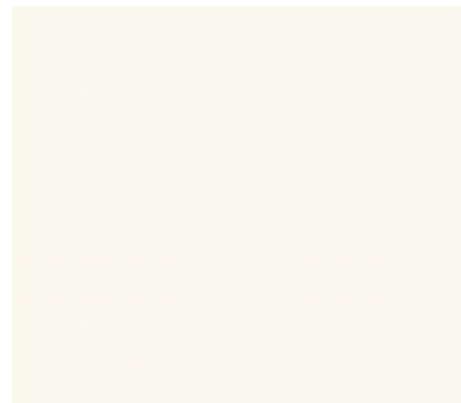
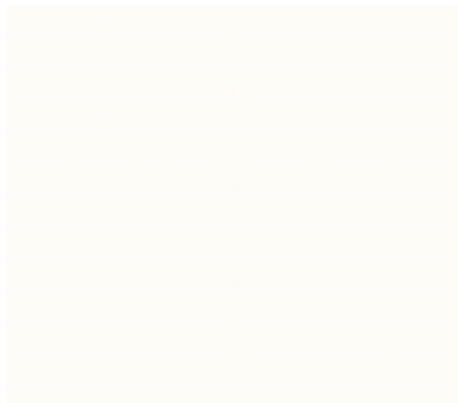
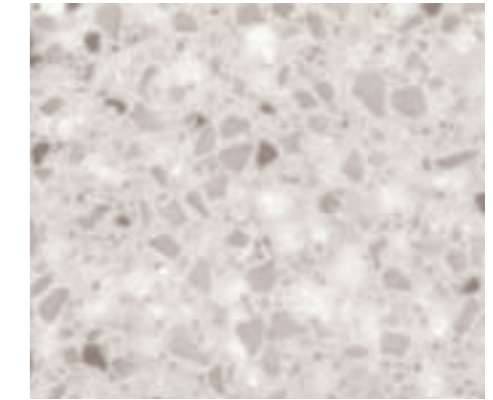
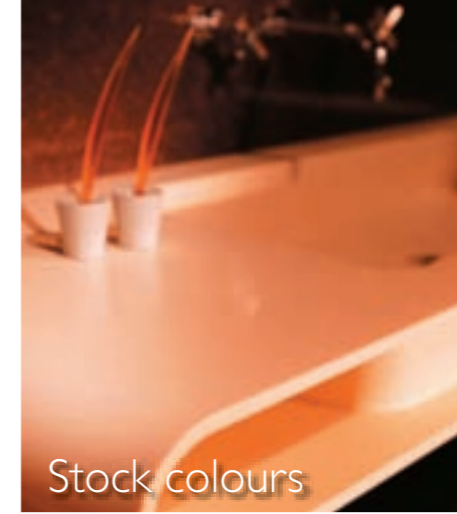
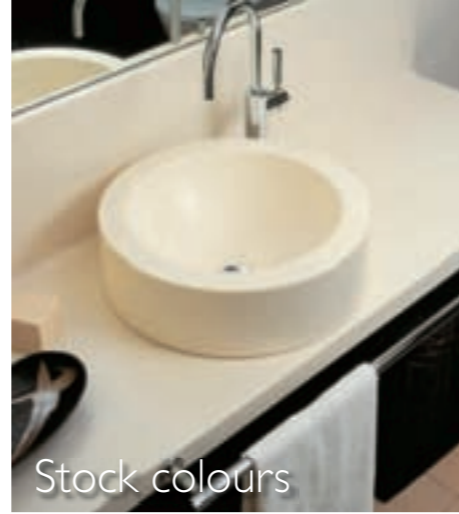
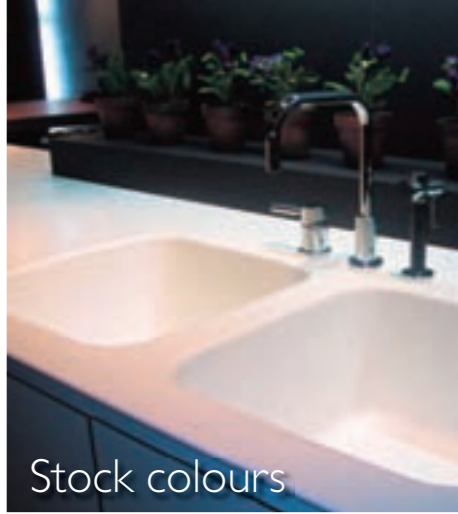
With a rich, natural translucence that is inviting to touch, Corian® offers design versatility, function and durability far beyond the scope of conventional materials.
